RICKINGHALL RAMBLERS REPORT 2023-24

The Rickinghall Ramblers has had a successful year with a full programme of walks which have been both local and further afield to a number of other villages, including Shelfanger, East Harling, Thelnetham, Gislingham, Badwell Ash, Thorndon Magna, and Bressingham. Walks happen on Mondays or Fridays, every 10 or 11 days. They tend to be 4 to 6 miles in length. Members of the group take responsibility for leading walks and so there is a rich and varied programme. They are advertised on notice boards in Botesdale and Rickinghall, and walk dates appear as an ad in the Parish Magazine.

Walks have been well attended. Most have had 12-16 people. There are currently about 35 people on the group's database. There is no membership fee. Anyone wishing to go on a walk just needs to be at Rickinghall Village Hall on the walk day. The group leaves promptly at 9.15am. New members are very welcome.

In October there was an annual lunch at the White Horse, Badwell Ash. This is a long-standing tradition.
