

RICKINGHALL RAMBLERS 2020

The Rickinghall Ramblers is an informal walking group where members take responsibility for leading walks in the local area. Walks occur on a Monday or a Friday morning and the dates are published in the Parish Magazine, as well as on notice boards in Rickinghall and Botesdale. There is no membership fee. The group meets at Rickinghall Village Hall on walk mornings and those present depart at 9.15am.

The group has had a very successful year. There have had a number of very good walks at places like Bressingham, Hopton, Scole, East Harling, Tivetshall St Mary, as well as more local places. Walks tend to be four to six miles in length.

Walks have been well attended. Most have had about 12-16 people and a local one in early January had 27 walkers. There are currently over 60 members on the group's database. The walking programme and details of events are emailed to members, but hard copies are given to those without the internet.

There are two social events during the year. The annual lunch at The White Horse in October was attended by over 30 people and there was a similar number at the coffee morning in January.

New walkers are very welcome to join the group.
